February 10-March 5: Preschool registration opens for **existing families**. Students currently enrolled in a CSD preschool program are eligible to re-enroll online in their current preschool program.

Preschool New Family Open Registration for 2020-2021 School Year

On **March 6, 2020**, starting at noon, a form will be posted on www.CamasCommunityEd.org and www.Camas.wednet.edu. Upon completing the online form, parents will receive a confirmation email. This form is to schedule a registration appointment only. **The form will need to be completed and submitted by Sunday, March 8 at midnight** to be included in the registration lottery.
Monday, March 9: New Family Registrations are entered into a lottery for random number assignment.
Tuesday, March 10: Registration numbers will be emailed to families.

Pre-K 4 Year Old Program

Our 4 year old program focuses on kindergarten readiness for children who turn four by August 31, 2020. Led by a qualified preschool instructor and support staff, students will learn classroom, social and academic skills to prepare them for a successful kindergarten year. Instructor uses research-based instructional practices and programs designed for kindergarten readiness. Childcare available before and after class for additional fee. Morning and afternoon sessions are available.

Preschool 3 Year Old Program

Our 3 year old program focuses on early childhood behavior for children who turn three by August 31, 2020. Led by a qualified preschool instructor and support staff, students will learn social skills to prepare them for a successful transition into their next adventure. Children will learn by sharing with their classmates and exploring the world around them in this fun, safe environment. Morning and afternoon sessions are available.
